Clipper Brings Periods of Snow and A Bit of Freezing Drizzle December 19-20

Start: 4:30 - 6 PM December 19th End: 6 - 7:30 AM December 20th

An initial batch of snow first built in 4:30 - 6 PM December 19th, lasting for an hour or so into the evening at a moderate to briefly heavy intensity. Brief and variable pavement coverage was able to occur within this activity as temperatures ranged between 31 - 34 degrees. Snow turned intermittent during the evening, allowing for occasional drizzle and freezing drizzle to mix in as temperatures held steady. Then, the backside of the clipper brought a final shot of moderate to heavy snow starting after 4:30 AM. Pavements quickly accumulated snow within this prolonged intensity, then snow began to lighten and exit 6 - 7:30 AM December 20th.

Clipper Brings Periods of Snow and A Bit of Freezing Drizzle December 19-20

Start: 3:30 - 5:30 PM December 19th End: 6 - 7:30 AM December 20th

Periods of snow first built in 3:30 - 5:30 PM December 19th, lasting for a couple hours into the evening at a moderate to briefly heavy intensity. Variable pavement coverage was able to occur within this activity as temperatures ranged between 30 - 32 degrees. Snow turned intermittent during the evening, allowing for occasional drizzle and freezing drizzle to mix in as temperatures slightly rose to 31 - 34 degrees. Then, the backside of the clipper brought a final shot of moderate to heavy snow starting after 4 AM. Pavements quickly accumulated snow within this prolonged intensity, then snow began to lighten and exit 6 - 7:30 AM December 20th.

Clipper Brings Periods of Snow and A Bit of Freezing Drizzle December 19-20

Start: 2:30 - 4:30 PM December 19th **End:** 5:30 - 7 AM December 20th



Periods of snow first built in 2:30 - 4:30 PM December 19th, becoming more numerous and falling at a moderate intensity into the evening. This allowed for some initial pavement coverage. Snow turned more intermittent through the evening, resulting in occasional periods of drizzle and freezing drizzle at times overnight. Then, the backside of the clipper brought a final shot of moderate to heavy snow starting after 3 AM. Pavements quickly accumulated snow within this prolonged intensity, then snow began to lighten and exit 5:30 - 7 AM December 20th. Temperatures ranged between 29 - 34 degrees through the event (29 - 31 in snow, 31 - 34 degrees in lulls / drizzle activity).
