

Illinois: November 20th - 21st, 2024

First Snow of the Season November 20-21

Start: 4:30 - 6:30 PM November 20th **End:** 1 - 2:30 PM November 21st

Mixed rain and wet snow showers transitioned to all snow showers 4:30 - 6:30 PM November 20th as temperatures settled from the 40s into the mid 30s. Light to moderate intensity snow showers continued overnight, tapering to a flurry during the predawn as temperatures cooled to 29 - 31 degrees by daybreak November 21st. These snow showers produced a scattered coating to a half inch of accumulation. Then, a widespread swath of moderate to occasionally heavy snow (up to 1" per hour) arrived 9 - 10 AM November 21st. Most snow accumulations occurred on colder surfaces, though pavements were able to cover at times in heaviest intensity, particularly through late-morning as temperatures remained below 32 degrees. Snow lightened, then mixed with and changed to rain showers 1 - 2:30 PM November 21st as temperatures quickly rose back into the mid 30s. Through the event, it was windy with occasional 30 - 35 mph wind gusts.

Snow lightened, then mixed with and changed to rain showers 12:30 - 2 PM November 21st as temperatures quickly rose back into the mid 30s. Through the event, it was windy with occasional 30 - 35 mph wind gusts.
