Intermittent Snow Showers and Freezing Drizzle January 5-6

Start: 7:30 - 9:30 PM January 5th **End:** 12 - 2 PM January 6th

Scattered and light precipitation first developed 7:30 - 9:30 PM January 5th with temperatures around 20 degrees. This was a mix of light lake effect snow showers and freezing drizzle. Scattered activity continued overnight, then transitioned to mostly freezing mist on the morning of the 6th. Occasional freezing mist continued, creating slick spots on all surfaces before wearing off 12 - 2 PM January 6th. By the end of the event, temperatures had risen to near 30 degrees.

Start: 7 - 9 PM January 5th **End:** 1:30 - 3:30 PM January 6th

Scattered and light precipitation first developed 7 - 9 PM January 5th with temperatures around 20 degrees. This was a mix of light lake effect snow showers and freezing drizzle. Scattered activity continued overnight, then transitioned to mostly freezing mist on the morning of the 6th. Occasional freezing mist continued through the day, creating slick spots on all surfaces before wearing off 1:30 - 3:30 PM January 6th. By the end of the event, temperatures had risen to near 30 degrees.

Intermittent Snow Showers and Freezing Drizzle January 5-6

Start: 6:30 - 8:30 PM January 5th **End:** 3:30 - 5:30 PM January 6th

Scattered and light precipitation first developed 6:30 - 8:30 PM January 5th with temperatures between 23 - 27 degrees. This was a mix of light lake effect snow showers and freezing drizzle. Scattered activity continued overnight, then transitioned more to freezing mist on the morning of the 6th. Occasional freezing mist continued through the day, creating slick spots on all surfaces. Only brief and light snow showers mixed in. Activity tapered to a leftover flurry / sprinkle by 3:30 - 5:30 PM January 6th. By the end of the event, temperatures had risen to near 30 degrees.
