### Storm Produces A Little Backside Snow March 16th

**Start:** 9 - 11 AM March 16th    **End:** 1:30 - 3:30 PM March 16th

Showers fell mostly as plain rain throughout the early part of the morning with temperatures around 40 degrees. A steadier area of precipitation grew to the north and west, then worked toward the area along with cooling temperatures of 32 - 34 degrees to allow rain to change to snow 9 - 11 AM March 16th. Snow did become briefly moderate to heavy for an hour or so through the midday, though was just confined to colder surfaces. All snow then ended 1:30 - 3:30 PM.

### Storm Produces Moderate to Briefly Heavy Snow March 16th

**Start:** 7:30 - 9:30 AM March 16th    **End:** 12:30 - 2:30 PM March 16th

Rain showers fell initially with temperatures 34 - 37 degrees. As an area of steadier precipitation filled in, a complete change to snow occurred 7:30 - 9:30 AM March 16th which coincided with temperatures that cooled to 30 - 32 degrees. Snow was moderate to briefly quite heavy for a time after the changeover especially mid-late until around midday. Snow then ended 12:30 - 2:30 PM as the storm exited east.

**Start:** 5:30 - 7:30 AM March 16th    **End:** 11:30 AM - 1:30 PM March 16th

Rain showers fell initially with temperatures 34 - 37 degrees. As a narrow band of steadier precipitation filled in, a complete change to snow

occurred 5:30 - 7:30 AM March 16th which coincided with temperatures that cooled to 30 - 32 degrees. Snow was occasionally moderate to heavy for a time after the changeover especially mid-late morning. Snow then ended 11:30 AM - 1:30 PM as the storm exited east.
