Wet Snow and Gusty Winds to Kick Off Spring March 20th

Start: 2 - 4 AM March 20th **End:** 7 - 8:30 AM March 20th

Outside of a short-lived rain/snow shower prior, steady, wet snow built in 2 - 4 AM March 20th with temperatures around 35 degrees. The wet snow fell at a moderate intensity through the predawn, and with temperatures cooling to 30 - 32 degrees, allowed for variable pavement coverage as consistent, wet snow continued. Winds also occasionally gusted around 30 mph, contributing to some blowing and drifting. Snow exited 7 - 8:30 AM.

Snow to Kick Off Spring March 20th

Timing: 2 - 8:30 AM March 20th

Between 2 - 8:30 AM March 20th, existing rain showers became wet snow as temperatures settled from the mid-upper 30s to 32 - 34 degrees. Snow was light to briefly moderate intensity, sticking to colder and grassy surfaces. Additionally, winds occasionally gusted to 30 mph, resulting in blowing snow.

Heavy, Wet Snow and Gusty Winds to Kick Off Spring March 20th

Start: 1 - 3 AM March 20th **End:** 7 - 8:30 AM March 20th

Heavy wintry precipitation first arrived 1 - 3 AM March 20th. With temperatures around 35 degrees, it was an initial mix of rain, sleet, and snow, which increasingly mixed with sleet and then became all snow as temperatures cooled to 32 - 33 degrees. Some pavement coverage occurred particularly under the heaviest intensities, then became more variable as the heaviest snow subsided through predawn. Steady, moderate snow still followed until all activity exited 7 - 8:30 AM. Despite the snow being of wet/dense nature, occasional wind gusts around 30 mph still resulted in blowing and drifting.

Heavy wintry precipitation first arrived 1 - 3 AM March 20th. With temperatures 34 - 36 degrees, it was an initial mix of rain, sleet, and snow, which increasingly mixed with sleet and then became all snow as temperatures cooled to 32 - 34 degrees. Spotty/variable pavement coverage occurred within the heaviest intensities, then pavements trended mostly wet as the heaviest snow subsided through predawn. Steady, moderate snow still followed until all activity exited 7 - 8:30 AM. Despite the snow being of wet/dense nature, occasional wind gusts around 30 mph still resulted in blowing and drifting.
